

Alcohol, Tobacco, and Substance Use

- Identify the specific type of drug or substance
- Describe the frequency of usage as:
 - Use
 - Abuse
 - Dependence
 - In remission
- Describe mode of nicotine use as cigarettes, chewing tobacco, pipe, and/or gum
- Specify intoxication/withdrawal as “Uncomplicated” or “With delirium”
- Document any withdrawal symptoms
- Document any associated diagnoses/conditions
- List the blood alcohol level, if available
- State “no related complications,” when applicable
- Document any related mood disorder
- Document any delusions, hallucinations, anxiety, sleep disorders, sexual dysfunctions, or other related conditions
- List any treatment provided:
 - Detoxification services
 - Counseling
 - Psychotherapy
 - Medication management
 - Pharmacotherapy
