

Aplastic Anemia

- For aplastic anemia and other bone marrow failure syndromes:
 - Specify if “Acquired pure red cell aplasia”
 - Chronic
 - Transient
 - Other
 - Specify if aplastic anemia is:
 - Constitutional
 - » Congenital, idiopathic or acquired
 - Drug-induced, radiation, or induced from other external agent
 - Idiopathic
 - Document pancytopenia or myelophthisis, if also present
- Document if any of the following are present:
 - “Acute posthemorrhagic anemia”
 - “Anemia in neoplastic disease”
 - “Anemia in chronic kidney disease”
 - “Anemia in other chronic disease”
 - List the chronic diseases
- Document if “Sideroblastic anemia” is:
 - Hereditary
 - Secondary due to disease
 - Secondary due to “drugs and toxins”
 - Congenital dyserythropoietic anemia
- Document if the Anemia is Due to Antineoplastic chemotherapy
- Document any associated diagnoses/conditions
